Day 1- Thursday 8 August 2024

Home pick up and transfer to Brisbane International Airport. Check in at the airport is a minimum of 2 ½ hours prior to flight departure. Our flight is scheduled to depart Brisbane at 11:35 a.m., arriving to Norfolk Island at 2:45 p.m. On arrival we will be met and transferred to the South Pacific Hotel. Burnt Pine



Shopping Village is an easy walk from our hotel. Visit Burnt Pine to purchase an afternoon snack (own expense) but don't over-indulge as later this afternoon we will be heading out to an island 'fish fry'. At the fish fry we will enjoy a feast of local dishes including salads, homemade coconut bread and mouth-watering fried fish. Our dinner venue overlooks



breathtaking coastal scenery. As the sun sets, live music will be playing in the background and local entertainment will be supplied by the Baunti Byuutis dancing group. Wine and beer are available at your own expense, or you are welcome to BYO drinks. After dinner we travel to the former convict settlement of Kingston. The stillness and stars are just as they were before mankind arrived in 1788. With the dramatic use of real-life sound, together with theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours take us through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era. After a big first day we return to the South Pacific Hotel.

Day 2 – Friday 9 August 2024

After breakfast, we visit Colleen McCullough's home. The world-renowned author called Norfolk Island her home for almost 36 years. Colleen and her husband Norfolk Islander, Ric Robinson, created a retreat and maintained their privacy to ensure that Colleen had a perfect environment for her writing. Some of her most powerful titles were created in this much-loved sanctuary. Be escorted through her magnificent home and view Ric and Colleen's priceless collection of artefacts gathered on their travels. This

afternoon we head out on our ½ day island tour visiting some of Norfolk's key historic areas, including Kingston, Cascade and Longridge. This is our chance to learn about the fascinating history of Norfolk Island. See the famous convict buildings and hear the stories told in full commentary by our local guide. The views from lookouts, overlooking the island's beautiful beaches, is breathtaking. Other highlights include the renowned Melanesian Chapel followed by afternoon tea. Dinner this evening is at Hilli's Restaurant. 'Hilli' is a Norfolk Island expression meaning "disinclined to exertion, relax, take it easy, and unwind". Sounds perfect!

On this tour we will also visit the Pier Store, the Boat Shed and the Crank Mill. At Cyclorama experience the unique 360 degrees panoramic painting that will take



you on an amazing journey. Witness bounty adventures and discover how the world's most famous mutiny created Pitcairn and Norfolk communities. Conceived by Norfolk Islander – Marie Baily this gigantic panoramic painting vividly illustrates the story of her ancestor Fletcher Christian. A spectacular 3D effect is achieved with realistic perspective and detailed artwork. The Progressive Dinner is our last dinner together as a group.
