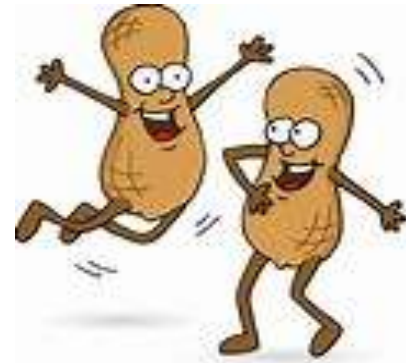

Day 1 – Friday 21 February 2025

HIGHLIGHT – MOFFATDALE RIDGE WINERY

Our day starts with a home pick up (Brisbane Metropolitan Area). You will be driven to our coach departure point and meet your fellow travellers and Oh Travel's tour host and driver. Our first stop will be Kilcoy, the home of the 'Yowie', where we stop for morning tea and a Yowie selfie. Our drive then takes us us to Moffatdale to enjoy wine tasting and lunch at Moffatdale Winery. The owner believes, as the old Italian's do, that wine should be made to be enjoyed by people on the land on which it is grown. At Moffatdale Ridge wines are made to be enjoyed with food. The D'vine Restaurant is a showcase of produce grown in the region. Following a leisurely lunch, we travel to Kingaroy for our 2 night stay.



HIGHLIGHT – KINGAROY OBSERVATORY Lose yourself in a galaxy far far away during a night visit to the observatory. Peer into the observatory's large telescopes to see close-up details of Mars, Jupiter, Moon Craters and Star Clusters. You will be given a running commentary during a 2-hour visit and a laser guided tour of the night skies.

HIGHLIGHT – LOCAL GUIDED TOWN TOUR

A local guide with years of local knowledge will join our group this morning to share all there is to know about Kingaroy and the surrounding area.



Day 2 - continued - Saturday 22 February 2025

HIGHLIGHT - TAABINGA HOMESTEAD Built in 1846 Taabinga Homestead is one of Queensland's oldest, continuously lived in rural homes. Our visit will include a guided tour of the main house and out-buildings including a dairy, butcher's shop and blacksmith's shed. Morning tea will be served at Taabinga Homestead.

HIGHLIGHT - BETHANY One of the most famous farms in Australia has been the home of the Bjelke-Petersen family for over 100 years. Today's visit will include a tour of the property covering all parts of this historic farm. Our host will share some stories of the Bjelke-Petersen family and their time in politics. A visit to 'Bethany' would not be complete without tea and pumpkin scones.

HIGHLIGHT - BUNYA RED FARM
