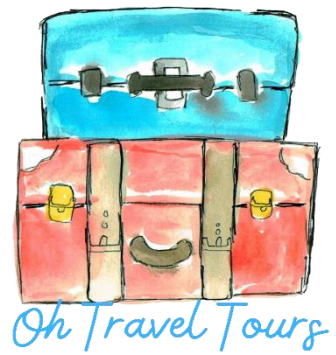

A NEW ENGLAND EASTER

ARMIDALE – TAMWORTH – GLEN INNES – INVERELL

Friday 18 April to Tuesday 23 April 2025

Friday 18 April 2025 – Brisbane to Armidale

Begin your New England Easter tour with a home pick up and travel to the coach departure point – Oh Travel Tours Corinda. On arrival at Corinda, you will be met by your tour host, coach driver and fellow travellers. Your journey this morning takes you to the city of Warwick known as the Rose and Rodeo city. Enjoy a picnic morning tea at Leslie Park before continuing via Stanthorpe to Tenterfield. Tenterfield is known as the

'Birthplace of the Nation' as this is where Henry Parkes delivered his famous speech about the future of federation in Australia. You will also have the opportunity to see the exterior of the Tenterfield Saddler Shop of Peter Allen fame. A couple of hours away is the city of Armidale known for its four distinct seasons which becomes like New England in the USA when, in autumn, the birch, ash and poplar trees set the area alight with reds, golds and browns.

Saturday 19 April 2025 – Armidale – Tamworth – Armidale

Over the past forty years Tamworth has become synonymous with country music. After breakfast today we're off on a day trip to the 'Country Music Capital of Australia'. Tamworth is only an 1 ½ hour scenic drive from Armidale. Today visit the world-renowned Country Music Hall of Fame, Australia's answer to Nashville USA. Here we will see an unmatched collection of memorabilia from Australian country music artists. On show there are many stage outfits, musical instruments and other displays. Each exhibit tells a unique story. 'Walk a Country Mile' is an interactive exhibition that tells the story of the inception of Tamworth as the country music capital. The lovely old town of Uralla is our next stop as we head back to Armidale. Uralla describes itself as 'Thunderbolt Country' and this is certainly demonstrated by the town's major claim to fame – the gentleman bushranger - Captain Thunderbolt. Thunderbolt is the main feature of the McCrossin Mill Museum known for its empathetic, humorous and even bizarre exhibitions.

SUNDAY 20 APRIL 2025 - ARMIDALE

Armidale was an important railway centre located on the main line from Brisbane to Sydney. The Armidale Bicentennial Railway Museum commemorates the role and work of generations of local men and women who worked for this once great transport service. On our visit this morning to the museum learn the history of the railway line and view a fascinating collection of historical railway wagons, machines and carriages.

Next - full steam ahead to Peterson's historic homestead for wine tasting and lunch. The homestead has been lovingly restored in line with traditional architecture. Wander through the English inspired gardens to the 'rustic cellar door', which operates out of the original homestead. At the cellar door sample cool climate wine varieties before enjoying a 2 course lunch.

Monday 21 April 2025 - Armidale - Inverell - Glen Innes

Today we head to Inverell to visit the National Transport Museum. This is not just any transport museum with over 200 exhibits from vintage cars to trucks, fire engines, motorcycles and even bicycles. After lunch at the museum we travel to Glen Innes. If you didn't know any better, you would swear you were in the



Scottish Highlands as we approach Glen Innes. Glen Innes connection to Scotland is celebrated at the Standing Stones Monument where enormous stones are arranged as a calendar incorporating the Celtic Cross and the Southern Cross in design. Glen Innes is rich in historic buildings, one being the 'Land of the Beardies History



House and Research Centre'. The centre has a fine collection of 19th century memorabilia. Do you know the history of the 'Beardies' name? It really is about 'men with beards'. Learn all on our visit to Glen Innes. Day 4 - Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner Today's itinerary is subject to change.
