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Day 1 - Friday 19 March 2027

Brisbane to Townsville – Spirit of Queensland



Home pick up (Brisbane Metropolitan Area) will be arranged to transfer you to Brisbane Roma Street Rail Station in plenty of time for the Spirit of Queensland 3-45 p.m. departure. Travelling 1,300 km by rail offers stunning scenery: passing sugarcane fields, dense tropical bushland and vast coastal wetlands. Your rail bed (sometimes referred to as a pod!) is a comfy seat during the day that converts to a bed in the evening. At night, after the evening service is complete and onboard activities start to

ease, your carriage attendant will convert your seat into a lie-flat bed with fresh sheets, fluffy pillows and a doona. Meals are delivered to you at your seat during the journey. Other refreshments can be purchased from the café. There are shared shower and toilet facilities at the end of each carriage. **Day 1 – Dinner on Train**

Day 2 – Saturday 20 March 2027 – Arrive Townsville

After waking, your carriage attendant will convert your bed back into your seat in time for breakfast service. Sit back, relax and enjoy the last few hours of your train trip. On arrival in Townsville at 10-30 a.m., transfer to your accommodation and take in the hotel's many amenities including the infinitely pool and casino. **Day 2 Breakfast on Train – Dinner**

Day 3 – Sunday 21 March 2027 – Townsville – Magnetic Island



Located just 8 km offshore and only a 35 minute ferry journey from Townsville, Magnetic Island is a true North Queensland treasure within the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park. With its tropical climate, friendly community and breathtaking natural beauty, the island is a perfect place to spend a day. On our island tour spot wild koalas and rock wallabies in their natural habitat, explore secluded bays and hear the stories behind the island's wildlife and WW2 history.

Day 4 – Monday 22 March 2027 – Townsville



Our morning guided tour of Townsville allows us the opportunity to take a walk along Townsville's waterfront, The Strand, with palm-lined paths and ocean views. Keep an eye out for the Ocean Siren, a striking sculpture rising from the sea just offshore that changes colour in



response to the ocean temperature. A visit to the 'Queensland Museum Tropics' delivers a snapshot of North Queensland with galleries telling the stories of Heritage listed rainforests, reefs and tragic tale of HMS Pandora, the ship sent to capture the Bounty Mutineers. Perched on a rocky headland at the northern end of The Strand stands Kissing Point Fortification. Overlooking the waters of Cleveland Bay and Rowes Bay a visit to the fortification offers a fascinating glimpse into the past while providing breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape. **Day 4 – Breakfast / Dinner** Today's itinerary is subject to change.

Day 5 – Tuesday 23 March 2027

Leaving Townsville this morning by private coach we head south to Airlie Beach, passing the Burdekin towns of Ayr and Home Hill. Our journey, of just over 3 hrs, passes tropical farming areas, towering granite boulders and, of course, sugarcane fields. A short stop in Bowen will allow time to stretch our legs and view the many murals painted on walls that depict the history of this coastal town. After dropping our luggage at our hotel take time to discover Airlie Beach. Downtown Airlie Beach is the vibrant walkable hub of the Whitsundays. There are numerous places to stop for lunch. Maybe purchase fish and chips and head along the esplanade to the lagoon featuring sandy man-made beaches, grassy picnic areas and beautiful views of the Coral Sea. Everything is an easy walk to our accommodation.

Day 6 – Wednesday 24 March 2027 - Airlie Beach

This morning we join Airlie Beach Adventure Tours for a relaxed sightseeing trip. After a short tour of the Airlie Beach area, we visit the Gold Coffee Plantation, where we discover how local beans are grown and processed. Next, we head into the rainforest at Cedar Creek Falls – a freshwater swimming hole tucked away in tropical greenery. The falls are only a 200 metre stroll from the carpark and well worth the visit. Our last stop is at the iconic 1950's George's Diner where

you can purchase lunch (own expense). Why not step back in time and order a burger with drink – maybe a spider!

Day 7 – Thursday 25 March 2027- Airlie Beach – Hamilton Island

Take a day to explore beautiful Hamilton Island at your own pace, the



largest inhabited island of the Whitsunday Islands. Browse the boutiques and galleries along the Marina Village main street, spend time at Catseye Beach and the main resort pool and enjoy a pub lunch at the Marina Tavern (included). Free use of the island shuttle bus allows you to travel around the island if you prefer not to walk. For the more energetic – take a hike in the hills. Keep an eye on the time, you don't want to miss the boat back



to Airlie Beach! **Day 7 – Breakfast & Lunch** Today's itinerary is subject to change.

Day 8 – Friday 26 March 2027 – Airlie Beach to Brisbane – Spirit of Queensland

Spend time in Airlie Beach today before our afternoon coach departure to Proserpine to connect with the Spirit of the Outback 5-25 p.m. departure. Our time in Airlie Beach today will allow for last minute shopping and exploring. Maybe take a stroll (or rent a bike) and enjoy the Bicentennial Broadwalk. Again, rail beds have been confirmed for our journey back to Brisbane. Dinner and breakfast will be served on-board. Arrival at Roma Street Station is about 9 a.m. on Saturday.

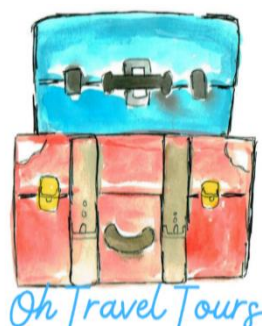
Spirit of Queensland – Carry On Luggage

Your carry-on bag should be no more than 23cm wide x 34cm high x 48cm long to fit in the overhead compartment above your seat or on the floor in front of your seat. No items can be placed under the Rail Bed due to space limitations.

Spirit of Queensland - Checked Luggage

Luggage allowance includes two (2) 20kg items per Rail Bed. Checked luggage will be available for collection at the end of the journey.

Cancellation and amendment fees will be levied once payment/s are made.
